Learning Objectives

Learners will know:

- about the national and international events of 2020 that have impacted on the black community
- about the national events of 2020 that have impacted on Museumand, The National Caribbean Heritage Museum

Learners will do:

- word games as a way of reinforcing knowledge learned in this session

Learners will understand:

- how Caribbean cultural history and heritage traditions are passed down the generations
- how aspects of Caribbean traditions and customs are promoted and celebrated in Britain

Learners will achieve:

- the completion of the exercise
- an understanding of how they can continue to learn about the black presence in Britain

Activity 1. - Based on the audio-recording

Reflect on the questions below and record your answers

- Why do you think Museumand chose to spell the title of their book as, '70 Objeks and Tings'?
- What did Museumand identify as the features needed to create an exciting museum? Do you agree?
- What is the significance of the number 70 to Caribbeans in the UK?
- The phrase, 'Riding on a white horse' was used by Museumand. What do you think this phrase means in this context?
- What are some of the traditional expectations of black parents when it comes to their children?

Activity 2. - Word Games

- How many smaller words can you make from the phrase - CONVERSATION? You can make words of 2 letters upwards. However, you can only use letters that are included in the word!
- What phrases are used in the conversation about George Floyd to convey 'something good can come out of something bad or difficult'? Can you think of any others?

Activity 3. - Follow-On Activity - Your Challenge

- What challenges has the Covid-19 pandemic presented to Museumand when it came to writing their book, '70 Objeks and Tings', and to running the museum as a whole?
- What have you learned from the conversation about the Windrush Scandal and about the relationship between black people and the police here in the UK and in the USA?
