#### Introduction

### Learning Objectives

Learners will know:

- about an iconic book Mother Country and in particular the chapter, *Barrel Children*
- some of the real-life stories of the Windrush children
- some Caribbean phrases

Learners will do:

• word games based on the readings from the Windrush children

Learners will understand:

- what it is like for migrants and their descendants to visit their country of origin
- the expectations and behaviours of people who visit their country of origin regularly

Learners will achieve:

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- the completion of the exercise
- an understanding of how the Windrush Generation supports family and friends in the 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> centuries

## Activity 1. - Watch Kimberly reading from the book

• Kimberly talks about children seeing other children wearing their clothes and playing with things that were once theirs. How would you feel seeing other young people using or wearing things that were once yours?

- In the film what memories are shared about the loves of Caribbeans in the UK?
- In the film what actions do Caribbeans take to support their families?
- What advice was given to listeners at the end of the film?

- When and why is the slang phrase 'Baby Father' used?
- What words or expressions can you find to describe the things you no longer need and give to others?

- How many words can you list to describe going from one place to another?
